Plein Air Painting Event Opportunity

The Oak Leaf Artist Guild has been invited by the city of Cottleville, MO in St. Charles County to stage a plein air "paint-out" along their main street sometime in May or June 2012. Cottleville is in the metro St. Louis area, near the intersection of Highway N and Motherhead Road (and south of St. Peters). They have been undergoing a renovation along their main street (which is Highway N), and they have quite a few little shops and eateries in the area. Some of their buildings are quite old, and they would be fun to paint because they have a lot of character. They also have a park nearby, Legacy Park, that artists could paint in, too. What they need to know is, when would we like to do it (if indeed we want to do it)? The Augusta Plein Air Art Event is going to be from April 18 - 28, so that would not interfere. Here are the weekends we are considering: May 5/6, May 12/13 (Mother's Day weekend, May 19/20, May 26/27 (Memorial Day weekend), June 2/3, and June 9/10.

So, would you be interested in taking part in this event? It could be a one or two-day affair. Let us know if you want to do it, and what dates would be good for you. They need to know by January 2012 so that they can publish their event calendar, so if you could get back to us as soon as possible that would be great! We have been discussing the idea of prizes or awards with them, but nothing is definite on that yet.
