### RULES OF ENTRY

All area artists are eligible to enter.

The show is open to amateur and professional artists. All artists will be judged by category only.

All work must be original. No copies or work done or completed under instruction will be accepted.

Artist agrees to pay 25% of sale of works sold to Arts Center.

Work must be delivered to the Community & Arts Center during the specified dates and times.

A total of three entries per artist is permitted. Two-dimensional art must be suitably framed, complete with screw eyes and hanging wire. No saw tooth hangers allowed.

All work must remain on exhibit through the end of the show. Works may be picked up during regular gallery hours.

Any piece that has ever won First Place or Best of Show at an Art Center sponsored show or Oakleaf show is not eligible for competition but may be accepted for exhibition only.

Liability: Precautions will be taken to safeguard work from loss or damage; however, the Oak Leaf Artist Guild, The St. Peters Community & Arts Center, or any person working with the show will NOT be responsible for loss or damage to any work.
